has preserved its 19th Century charm. Home of the Peter  
Britt Musical Festival, a summer-long concert series featuring  
world-class performers in classical, jazz, folk/country,  
musical theater, and dance which takes place in the outdoor  
amphitheater especially designed to accommodate the  
spectacular view of the beautiful Rogue Valley. Guests can  
reserve stadium seats or spread a blanket on the lawn for a  
picnic & performance (special picnic dinners prepared by  
the Inn) on starlit nights that consistently grace the summer  
evenings in Jacksonville. Features historical museum, art  
galleries, and antique shops. Restored historic home tours.  
Includes historic trails for hiking and biking.

## About The Inn

HOUSED IN ONE of gold-rush Jacksonville's early permanent structures, the Inn perpetuates the nostalgic romances of that era. Built in 1861, the walls of the dining area and lounge were built of locally quarried sandstone, and specks of gold are still visible in the mortar. The Inn extends to its visitors the ambiance of early western American and offers its guests an epicurean experience associated with superb dining along with luxurious hotel accommodations. It has become a nationally acclaimed restaurant and has been featured on CNN and the

Learning Channel's "Great Country Inns." As one of Oregon's most award-winning restaurants, the Inn has also been recognized by the *Pacific Northwest Magazine* and the *Oregon Magazine* as one of Oregon's best restaurants. The *Medford Mail Tribune* has bestowed on the Inn its "Readers' Choice Award – Best

Restaurant" for five consecutive years. The Inn also received *The Wine Spectator* "Best of Award of Excellence" for its comprehensive and unique wine list. It is located in the center of the Southern Oregon Wine Country just 7 miles west of Medford, Oregon's fourth largest city. It is a short and comfortable four-hour drive from Portland on Interstate 5 and a six-hour drive from San Francisco.



THE INN DINNER HOUSE offers superb dining with distinctive cuisine; a five-course Table d'Hote or lighter Bistro menu, a full-service lounge and a selection of over 2000 wines. The entire Inn has wireless internet access.

- ◆ Unique gifts for all occasions.

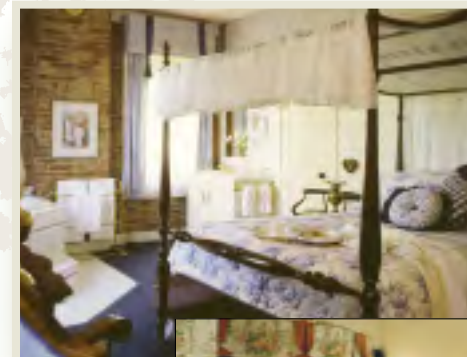
